he Freedom Foundation and CEO Tom McCabe are notorious for clogging our mailboxes with spam emails and unwanted junk mail. Even worse, the Foundation's political operatives often brag about harassing public employees at our workplaces — and at our homes.

Putting the safety and privacy of school employees at further risk, the Foundation recently requested the birth dates for ALL public employees. In media reports, Foundation employees said they will use our private information to continue their harassment campaign against education employees.

OEA is fighting to protect our safety and privacy in the courts and the Legislature. Meanwhile, McCabe's intentions are clear. He recently described OEA members as the "enemy" and vowed to "bankrupt" us and to "dramatically reduce" our ability to advocate for students. The Freedom Foundation is trying to undermine our public schools. They want to weaken OEA and our local unions so we have less of a united voice.

The Freedom Foundation has ties to Betsy DeVos and other wealthy corporate interests — yet they refuse to say who is funding their attacks on unions. The good news is that while their tactics are annoying and intrusive, OEA members are more united than ever — especially as more and more educators learn about the Freedom Foundation's *real* agenda.
